WHAT TOOLS CAN YOU USE?

MANUAL FOR TRAINERS

Manual (not only) for trainers offers a comprehensive insight into the topic of disinformation with methodological tips how to approach the issue. It is tailored for adult educators but recommended to anyone seeking a theoretical foundation for disinformation presented in a comprehensible way.

WEB APP

Web app is an interactive online tool offering short texts, quizzes and videos to help adults improve their skills and knowledge on fake news and disinformation. It also includes a dedicated section for trainers on specifics of teaching older adults.

DYNAMIC DEMOSTRATOR

The last project result presents an online learning environment with real-life interactive scenarios so adults can gain further understanding of the concepts of fake news and disinformation.

Our overarching goal has been to raise awareness about **intentional fake news and disinformation**, shedding light on their pervasive impact on decision-making processes.
